"Create in me a clean heart, O God, and put a new and right spirit within me." James 1:22


Please join us as we begin Lent on March 9th at our Ash Wednesday Service at 6:30 PM.



This weekend Renee and I watched the movie Secretariat. Just in case you don't know who Secretariat was, he was winner of horse racing's Triple Crown in 1973. Before Secretariat was able to win the Triple Crown his owner had to make a difficult decision. Secretariat's owner was faced with over six million dollars in debt and the possibility of losing everything in the face of this unimaginable debt. Then she seemed

to have her answer, she was offered eight million for Secretariat. She could pay off all debt and save the farm. No one in their right mind could turn down such an offer. Yet she did, she said no. She gave up a sure thing because she believed that her horse was worth much more.

As we approach the season of Lent, I find myself thinking about what this woman gave up out of faith in her horse. Lent is the time of year when we reflect and evaluate our lives and how we live. It is a time to take stock of who and what we are and get rid of the things that are of no value. Many of us will symbolically give up something that we enjoy during Lent. This reminds us of what Jesus gave up for us at Calvary. He gave it all, His very life.



During Lent this year, don't just give up something for the season. Give up something forever, give up control and have faith in the one who gave his all for you.

"Let this mind be in you which was also in Christ Jesus, who, being in the form of God, did not consider it robbery to be equal with God, but made Himself of no reputation, taking the form of a bondservant, and coming in the likeness of men.
