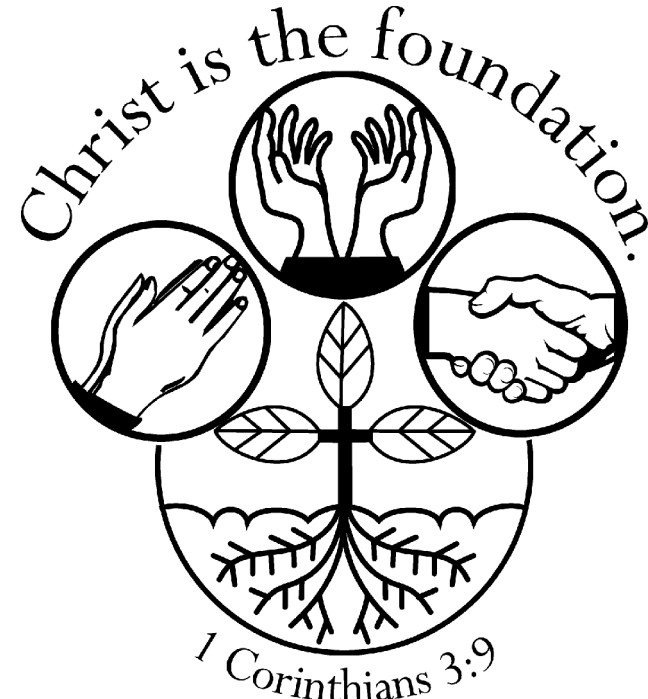

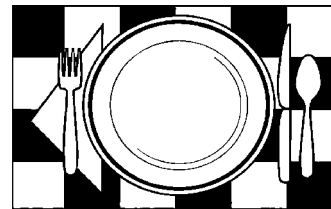

Safety of Over-the-Counter Cough and Cold Medicines for Kids

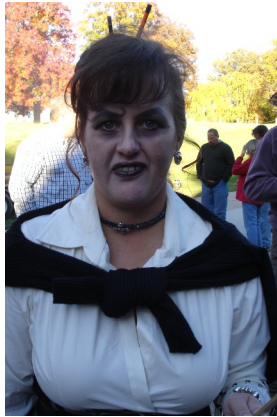
Here are some tips to use over-the-counter medicines safely in children.

1. *Always read and follow the Drug Facts label on the medicine.* Be sure you clearly understand how much medicine to give and when another dose can be given.
2. *Know the "active ingredient" in your child's medicine.* This is what makes the medicine work and many cough, cold and fever medicines contain the same ingredients. Giving two different products together can lead to side effects and possible overdose.
3. *Give the right medicine, in the right amount, to your child.* Medicines with the same brand name can be sold in different strengths such as infant, child and adult formulas.
4. *Use the dosing tool that comes with the medicine to measure out the amount.* Never use a kitchen spoon to measure medicines.
5. *Know the difference between a tablespoon (tbsp) and a teaspoon (tsp).* A tablespoon holds 15 cc or 15 mL and a teaspoon holds 5 cc or 5 mL. A mL is equal to a cc.
6. *Know your child's weight.* Directions on some medicines are based upon weight. Never guess the amount to give to your child or try to figure it out from the adult dose instructions. If a dose is not given for your child's weight or age, call your doctor or pharmacist for help.
7. *Protect your family from accidental poisons.* Use child-resistant caps. Be especially careful with medicines that contain iron; they are the leading cause of poisoning deaths in small children.
8. *Store medicines in a safe place.* Today's medicines are tasty, colorful, and may look like candy. Store them out of your child's (and your pet's) sight and reach.
9. *Do a triple-check before you give medicine to your child.* Make sure you have the right medicine for the right child; measure it out with the device that comes with the bottle; and check the dose one last time before the child takes it.
10. *If you suspect a poisoning, call the Poison Center Hotline right away.*

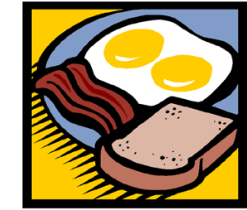
Bryce Shook won the "How many M & M's?" contest & everyone was a winner at the **Go Fish Booth** thanks to Sweetie & Honey McCain.





The current green altar cloths are over 40 years old and new
